Standards

Dress Standards: There may be occasions when students are requested to wear dress clothing. Boys should have a white button down dress shirt, dress pants, tie and dress shoes available. Girls should wear Sunday dress and dress shoes.

Appearance Guidelines

Boys: Male students must have a standard, conservative haircut. No "punk" or "fad" hair styles. The hair is to be tapered and is to be off the collar. It is to be above the ears, with sideburns no longer than the middle of the ears. No facial hair is permitted on students. Belts are to be worn on all pants with belt loops.

Girls: Girls should wear dresses and skirts which are no shorter than the bottom of the knee. No splits above the knees are allowed. Dresses and blouses must come to the neckline in front (to the clavicle bone) and back (to the bottom of the neck), without see-through material. Hosiery, makeup, and jewelry should be conservative.

Note: Students may have plain jackets, book bags, totes, lunch boxes, etc... (NO pictures and NO writing allowed on these items, except the student's or school's names).

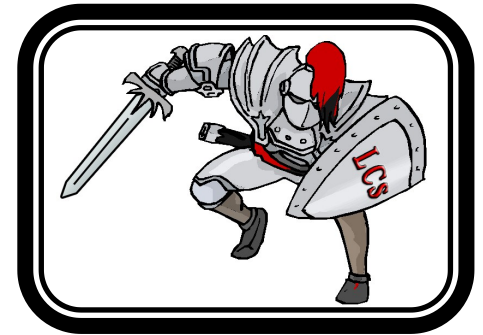
Those who want to participate in Sports or P.E. Classes must meet the dress standards of Lighthouse Christian School.

The goal at Lighthouse Christian School is to train the entire family to serve the Lord. It is not just a school; it is a ministry. Lighthouse Christian has continued to maintain the ACCELERATED CHRISTIAN EDUCATION SCHOOL OF TOMORROW Model status throughout its existence. This is the highest standard of excellence a school using the Accelerated Christian Education curriculum can attain. Lighthouse Christian School has an educational program from K-5 through the 12th grade. Its program facilitates learning from the second to twelfth grade through self-instructional materials requiring a minimum of adult supervision while enabling students with varied abilities to advance academically. A student can develop skills while working at his own academic level within the limits of his own ability and according to his own background. Through controls and motivation, he is able to advance to his highest potential.

Student achievement is often hampered by grading and grouping students according to their chronological age. Through national achievement tests and diagnostic testing the student is evaluated relative to vocabulary and cognitive skills. This makes it possible to prescribe his curriculum at his actual level of performance. A student's level is determined by ability, not age.

It is the desire of Lighthouse Baptist Church to help families raise their children in an environment with *Biblical values and a quality Christian Education that is second to none.*

ALL Fees are Non-REFUNDABLE

All **monthly payments** are due on the first of month and a late fee will be added after the tenth of the month.

There are other fees for graduating Seniors. For accreditation a student must be enrolled in our program for two years and must meet all academic requirements.

NOTE: *Any student who wishes to enroll in Lighthouse Christian School during any portion of a quarter, will only need to pay the difference between the Home School Price and the Regular School Price.*

Students may participate in extra curricular activities with Lighthouse Christian School, if the Activity Fee is paid.

All students must compete at the Jr. or Deep South Regional Student Conventions or the GACS Fine Arts Convention. All the students ages 8-12 years old are eligible for the Deep South Jr. Convention regardless if they are enrolled in our program or not. Each student to qualify for the Deep South Regional Convention must be currently enrolled and actively studying in a complete course of at least two of the five Accelerated Christian Education core subjects (math, English, social studies, science, or Word Building). If not they must attend the GACS Fine Art Program each year.

GENERAL Information

LCS Home Study Program is extension of Lighthouse Christian School. Lighthouse Christian has continued to maintain MODEL SCHOOL STATUS with the Accelerated Christian Education curriculum. Lighthouse Christian School is fully accredited through GAPSAC of the Georgia Association of Christian School which is recognized by the State of Georgia. The students enrolled in our home school program will receive the benefits of accreditation through GAPSAC provided the student meet the same requirements that Lighthouse Christian School meet. We are also able to allow students to be dual enrolled with the Accelerated Christian Education program. There will be an annual fee of \$200 per student that would like to dual enrolled with ACE. The student must meet all the academic requirements plus attend Regional Student Convention for dual enrollment.

Our home study program facilitates learning from the second to twelfth grade through the Accelerated Christian Education curriculum which is a self-instructional materials requiring a minimum of adult supervision while enabling students with varied abilities to advance academically. A student can develop skills while working at his own academic level within the limits of his own ability and according to his own background. Through controls and motivation, he is able to advance to his highest potential. However, if a parent prefer to use another curriculum then the parent must submit lesson plans and tests for each subject the 30th of each month. If not received by the 5th of the next month a late fee of \$50 will be added.

Parents must submit a student application, Certified Birth Certificate, Immunization Records, EED (GA Form 3300) and copy of Social Security Card along with all fees upon registration.

Parents must follow the LBC school calendar for attendance and the same daily academic time per week for their student. Attendance report, all lesson plans and tests for each subject must be mailed to our office every month.

Help is available during all regular office hours by phone, or by coming in to the office.

You may call, e-mail, or write if you have questions, or you may come into the office at any time during regular office hours. Except for holidays, we are open Monday thru Friday, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.
